

SEP 14 / Day 0 / Departure Manila : Check in at Ninoy International Airport. Enjoy on board entertainment and amenities.

SEP 15 / Day 1 / Arrival Rome (D): Upon arrival at the airport meet your driver and local guide. Board your coach enjoy a guided city tour. During the tour, you will see the highlights, such as Colosseum, Roman Forum, Trevi Fountain, Spanish steps, Pantheon and Piazza Navona. Transfer to the hotel, check in, remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

SEP 16 / Day 2 / Rome (B,D): Breakfast at your hotel. Meet your local guide and enjoy a guided visit of the Vatican museums with Sistine Chapel and the St. Peter Basilica. The Vatican City, home to the Pope, has many spectacular buildings and churches. It is actually the world's smallest independent sovereign state. The St. Peter Basilica was built over 1,500 years ago and can hold a staggering amount of 60,000 people! The Sistine Chapel, was painted by Michelangelo in 1508. This enormous ceiling, with scenes depicting the story of creation, took the artist over three years to complete. Free time to have lunch. Drive back to hotel. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

SEP 17 / Day 3 / Rome – Montecasino – San Giovanni Rotondo (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, you will take a long distance drive to Montecasino, the Abbey founded by St. Benedict in the year 529 and built on top of a mountain. The Benedictine rule of “Ora et Labora”, meaning “Pray and Work” follows 8 hours of prayer, 8 hours of sleep & 8 hours of manual work or spiritual reading or charity. It is written that one notorious monk disagreed with this rule and tried to poison St. Benedict. When St. Benedict made the sign of the cross, the chalice that contained the poison broke and the plot was discovered. In another mountain was the abbey where his twin sister St. Scholastica once led young women to the monastic life. We proceed to San Giovanni Rotondo - the small town where Padre Pio's incorrupt body is entombed in the Church of Our Lady of Grace. Continue to San Giovanni Rotondo and meet your local guide. After celebrating Holy Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Grace, we pay homage to the exhumed incorrupt body of St. Pio of Pietrelcina. Padre Pio bore the 5 wounds of Jesus for 50 years. Throngs of people were drawn to his confessional. He brought peace of mind, consolation and serenity to thousands. He had the gifts of healing, bilocation and prophecy. His burial was attended by more than 100,000 people. People would line up at the church entrance for 2 hours to attend his masses. He died at the age of 81. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

SEP 18 / Day 4 / San Giovanni Rotondo – Lanciano – Loreto – Assisi (B,D) : We will have breakfast at our hotel before we embark on a drive up the Adriatic coast to Lanciano where we will see the Eucharistic Miracle and celebrate Mass. We then continue on to the great Marian shrine of Loreto to visit the Holy House of Nazareth and the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. More than 50 popes have made a pilgrimage to the house transported by angels to this hill in central Italy in 1294. Tradition has it that this is the house in which Mary first prayed the Magnificat, in which Jesus grew to manhood, and in which the Holy Family lived. End of the day transfer to Assisi. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

SEP 19 / Day 5 / Assisi – Pisa (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. Enjoy a beautiful day in the most loved St. Francis. Commune in the Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humility, forgiveness, simplicity and love for all God's creatures. Hear about monastic life and view priceless frescoes adorning the walls of

the church. Nearby is the Church wherein lies the incorrupt body of St. Claire. Enjoy a guided tour through Assisi. After lunch, continue to the center of Pisa for pictures of its amazing Leaning Tower. Have a plentiful shopping. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Pisa.

SEP 20 / Day 6 / Pisa – Turin (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, board your coach and transfer to Turin. Upon arrival bring a visit on own to the Cathedral of Turin. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Turin.

SEP 21 / Day 7 / Turin – La Salette – Paray Le Monial (B,D)
Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, transfer to La Salette. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided tour of La Salette. Located in a high alpine pasture in the French Alps, La Salette is the site where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1846 to two shepherds, Melanie Matthew and Maximin Gird. A spring forever marks the spot where the Virgin appeared and where millions of pilgrims come in order to drink the fresh spring water and to pray. The stunning mountain scenery and lush mountain trails make La Salette one of the most spectacular pilgrimage sites in France, with a beautiful Basilica built to honour the Virgin Mary. Drive onward to Paray le Monial. Dinner and hotel overnight in Paray Le Monial.

SEP 22 / Day 8 / Paray Le Monial – Nevers – Paris (B,D) : Breakfast at the hotel, Proceed to Paray le Monial, cradle of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus; the most venerated spot is the Chapel of the Visitation, where most of the apparitions to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque took place. See the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, one of the most beautiful monuments of 10th and 11th century Cluniac architecture. On to Nevers to see the convent of St. Gilard where you will find the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette Soubuirous who spent her life here as a nun after leaving Lourdes. Drive to Paris. Arrival Paris, enjoy the SEINE RIVER CRUISE. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

SEP 23 / Day 9 / Paris (B,D) : Breakfast at hotel; meet your guide at the hotel lobby and then proceed for a visit to the Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal where you'll pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame, one of the greatest Gothic churches in the world with its magnificent stained-glass windows. The Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus of Paris, commonly known as Sacré-Coeur Basilica, a Roman Catholic Church and minor basilica, dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in Paris, France. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

SEP 24 / Day 10 / Paris – Lisieux – Normandy (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. This morning you will depart to Lisieux. Enjoy GUIDED TOUR, an orientation tour of Lisieux with visits to the places associated with the life of St. Therese including the Great Basilica dedicated to her, the Carmelite Convent, the Buissonnets (home of the Martin family), and other places of importance. End of the day transfer to Normandy. Dinner and overnight in Normandy.

SEP 25 / Day 11 / Normandy – Mont St. Michel – Pontmain (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, transfer to Mont St. Michel and enjoy a guided tour. Here you will see one of the most spectacular sights of Normandy. In the afternoon transfer to Pontmain, where you will visit the picturesque Cathedral, Lady of Pontmain. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Pontmain.

SEP 26 / Day 12 / Pontmain – Lourdes (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, board your coach and enjoy full day drive to Lourdes. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel for check in. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure.

SEP 27 / Day 13 / Lourdes (B,D) : Breakfast at the hotel, Half Day Guided Tour Of Lourdes and then continue for a Eucharistic Celebration. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie or visit a museum on her life. Pray collectively the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. GAIN PLENARY INDULGES! Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

SEP 28 / Day 14 / Lourdes – Salamanca (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, enjoy full day drive towards Salamanca. Upon arrival, check in and remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Salamanca

SEP 29 / Day 15 / Salamanca – Fatima (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, meet your local guide and enjoy a half day guided tour of Salamanca, a famous university cities in Spain that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1988. You will get to know its oldest squares and gardens and its many churches including the Old and New Cathedrals of Salamanca that join in a place known as Patio Chico, one of the most charming corners of the city. You will learn that the Old Cathedral is of the 12th century and of Romanesque style while the New Cathedral is much larger, and was built in the 16th century of Gothic style and completed in the 18th century. You will also stop at the Plaza Mayor, which is the main square in the heart of the city. In the afternoon board your coach and transfer to Fatima. Dinner and overnight in Fatima.

SEP 30 / Day 16 / Fatima (B,D) : Breakfast at the hotel. Participate at the morning Eucharistic Celebration. Meet your local guide for a half-day guided tour. In Fatima you will experience the beauty of the spiritual town. You will see the Basilica, the site of Francesco and Jacinta's graves, the Hamlet of Aljustrel, where the children live, and Valinhos, the site of Our Lady's appearance after the children's return from prison. Experience Christ's love as you walk and follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) culminating in the Chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima. After the tour, free time. Group dinner and overnight at your hotel.

OCT 1 / Day 17 / Fatima – Santarem – Lisbon (B,D) : Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, board your coach and transfer to Lisbon, via Santarem. In Santarem visit the famous Eucharist Miracle of Santarem on own. Continue on to Lisbon. Upon arrival enjoy a half day guided city tour of Lisbon. You will see all the highlights such as the Belem tower, Monument to the Discoveries and Monastery of Jeronimo. The tour is included with a visit to the Monastery of Jeronimo. End your tour with a visit of Castel Sao Jorge. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Lisbon.

OCT 2 / Day 18 / Departure Lisbon (B) : Breakfast at your hotel. Day at leisure for own sightseeing until transfer to the airport. meet your guide at the airport for the flight back to Manila.
